Tony Robinson (Ireland) is an award-winning oil painter of portraits and plein air landscapes, participating in Sky Arts Portrait Artist of the Year 2020.

Whether for a landscape or a portrait, Tony prefers to work alla prima. His goal is to capture the portrait sitter's likeness and presence or, in a landscape painting, to record the atmosphere and sense of place. His style strives to be both direct and nuanced, aiming to move swiftly towards a resolution of the image, while remaining ready to capitalise on random marks or effects and what they can contribute to the end result.

In 2008, Tony and some friends initiated Art in the Open, an annual plein air festival in Ireland. It is now the largest of its kind in Europe and attracts international well-known landscape artists.

Tony's Portrait Masterclass sold out quickly, and as a special treat, he will be doing a two-hour portrait demonstration, working with a live model.


Leon HolmesFeature Artist & Masterclass facilitator






