

Working primarily in oils, Michele also explores acrylics, gouache and watercolour.



Aaron Schuerr (USA) is an internationally recognised plein air artist who works in pastels and oils.

Aaron has embarked on solo plein air painting treks across the Grand Canyon, over the Beartooth Mountains, and deep into the alpine wilderness areas of Montana and Colorado.

He also makes regular trips to the coast, painting and teaching workshops in Maui and along the California coast.






